To Whom it May Concern:

California's Proposition 65, also known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, was enacted in the state of California in 1986. The Act lists chemicals known to the State of California to "cause cancer, birth defects or reproductive harm" and requires that companies provide a "clear and reasonable" warning to California consumers before exposing them to any of these chemicals.

Toddy Gear has fully tested its decorating and printing inks used to decorate its products in the USA and Mexico. The inks used do not contain chemicals at concentrations that would require a Proposition 65 Warning label.

Toddy Gear has in place a testing program that enforces a restricted substance list (RSL) which includes chemicals listed under California's Prop 65. Our vendors are required to abide by this RSL to prevent regulated chemicals from being found in our products. While Prop 65 Safe Harbor limits have not been established for all materials used in Toddy Gears products, and from time to time those limits change, Toddy Gear does not intentionally add chemicals that require a warning label.

For products manufactured on or after August 30, 2018, should Toddy Gear become aware that a product requires a Prop 65 Warning, we will indicate on our website any such item that requires a warning label and will apply a short form warning label to the product prior to shipment.
